Ten-Year Seasonal Performance vs the S&P 500



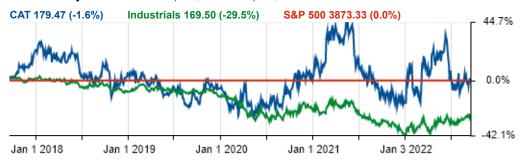
5-YEAR RELATIVE PERFORMANCE VS S&P 500

Overall Rating vs. Peers



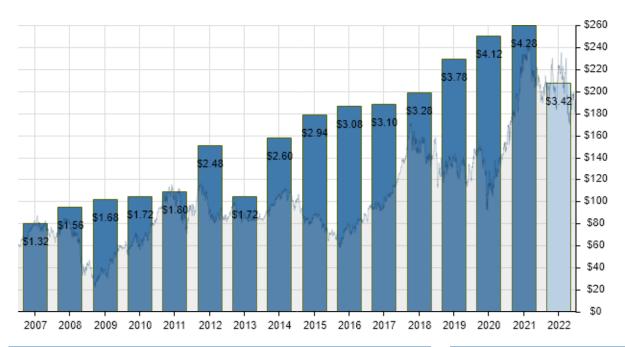
